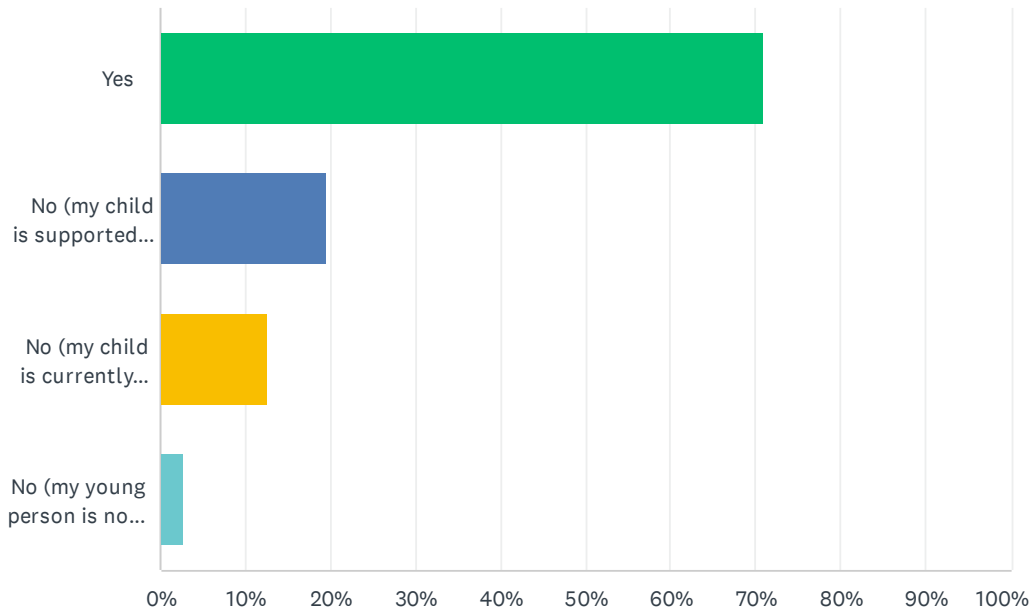


# Q1 Does your child/children have an EHC Plan? (Please tick all that apply)

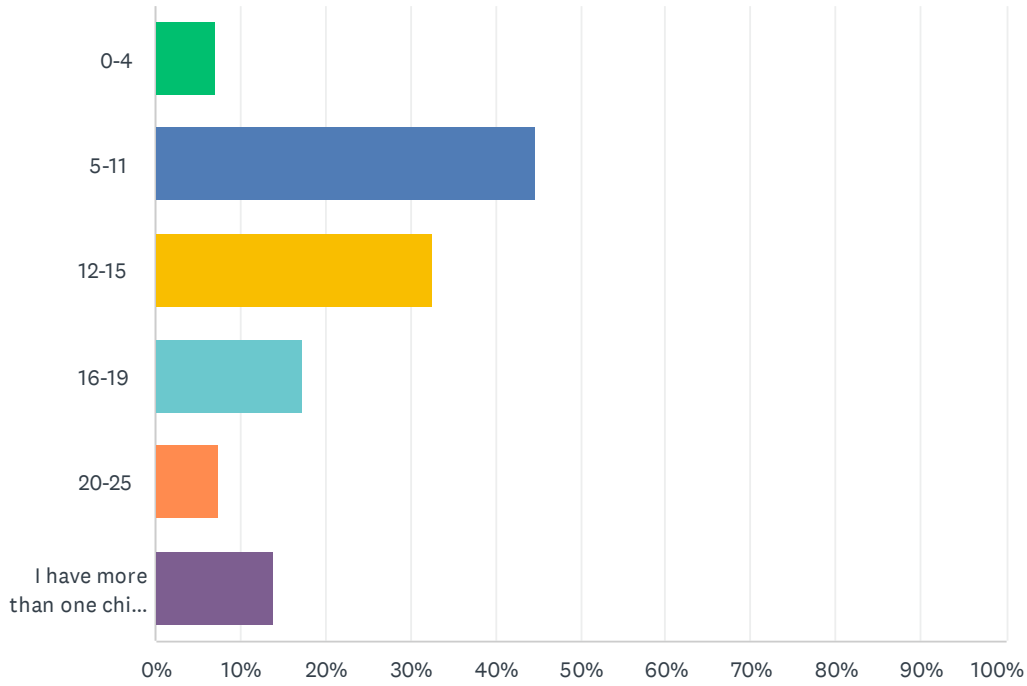

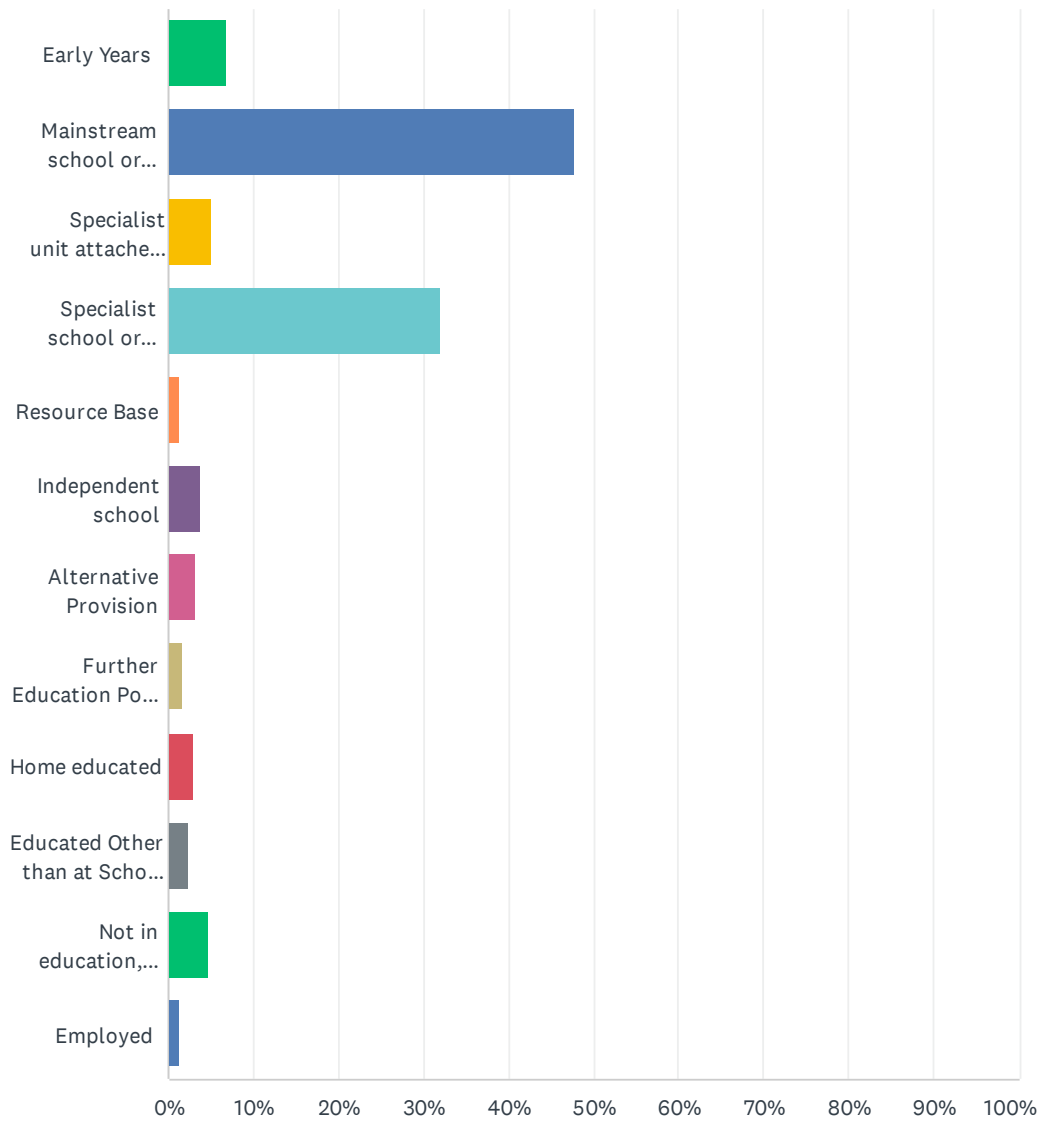

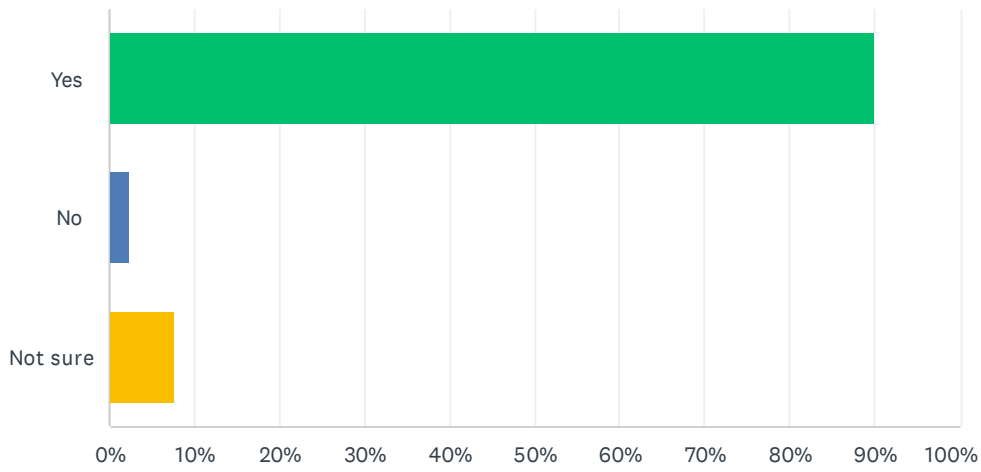

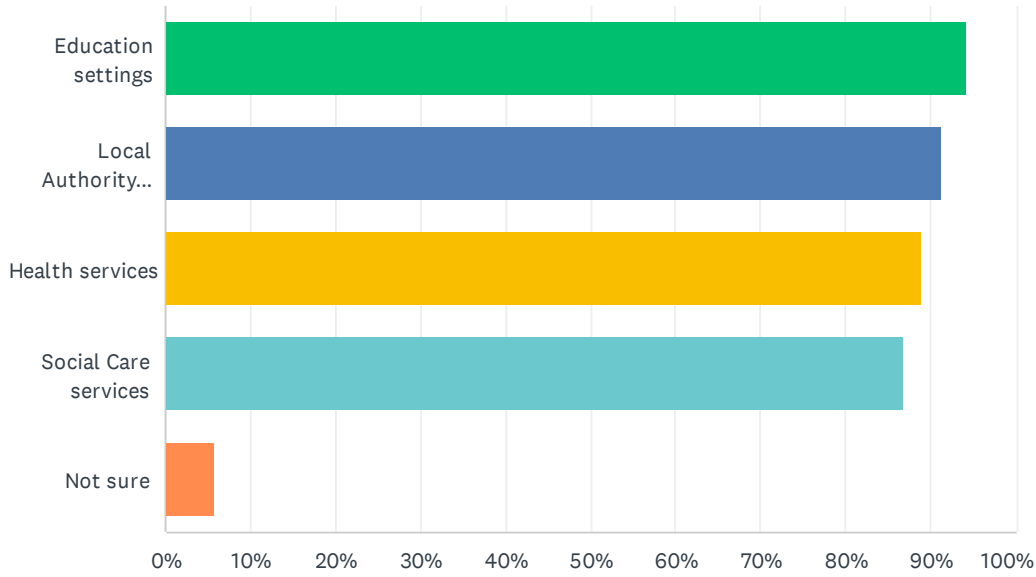

Q5 Do you think that the national SEND standards should apply to (tick all that apply):

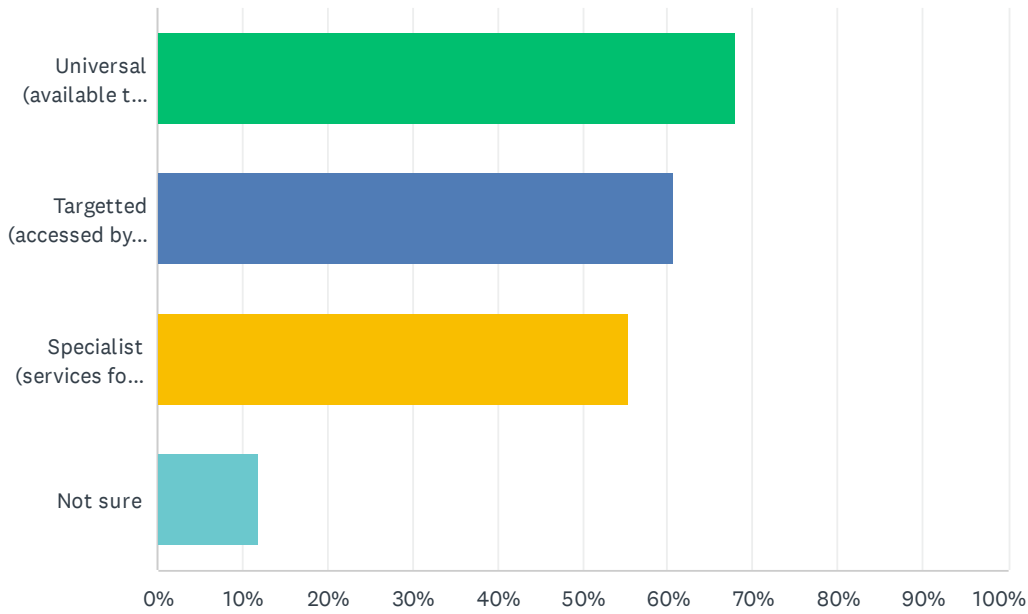

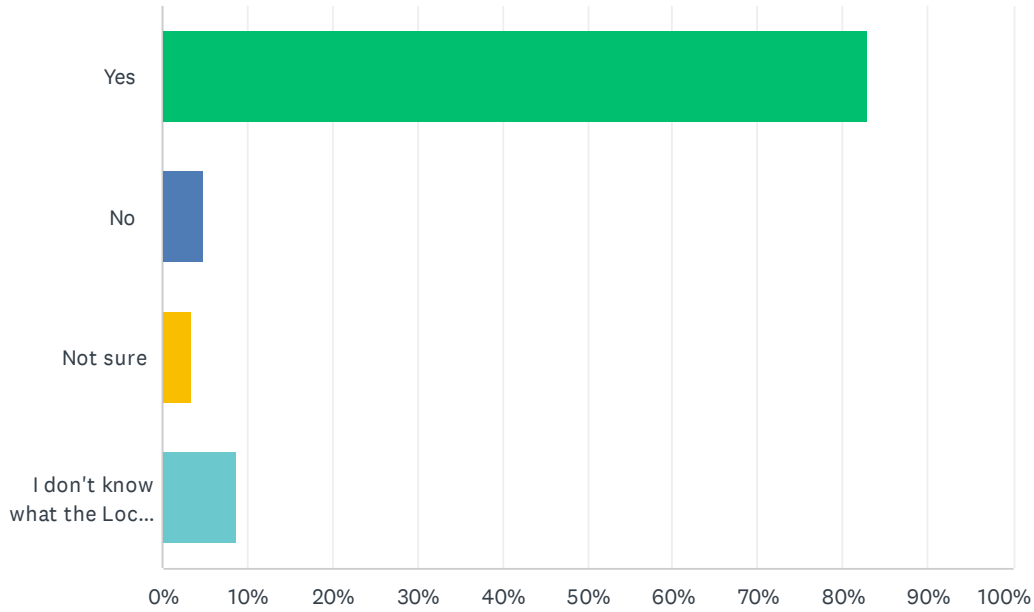

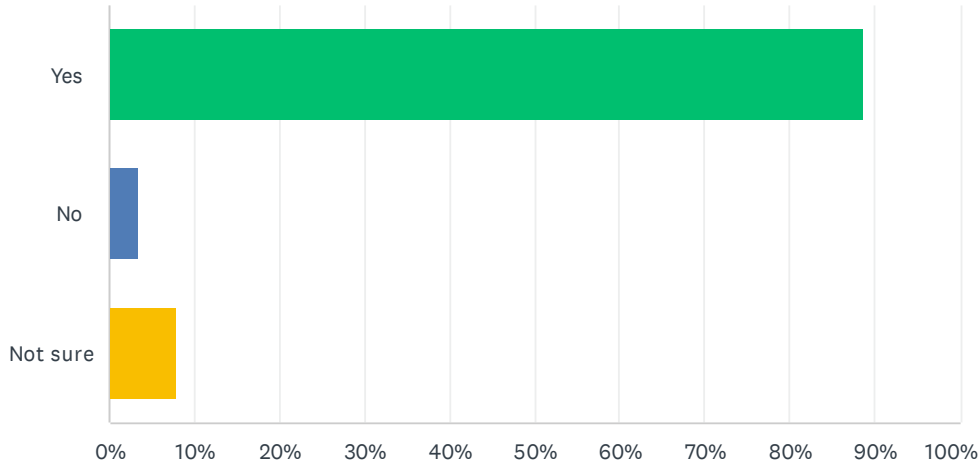

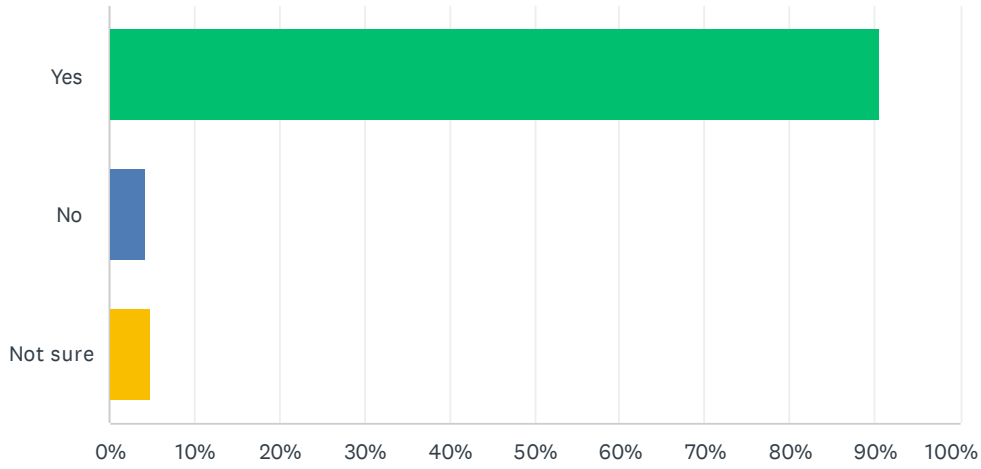

## Q9 Do you think that standards should include a maximum waiting time for services?

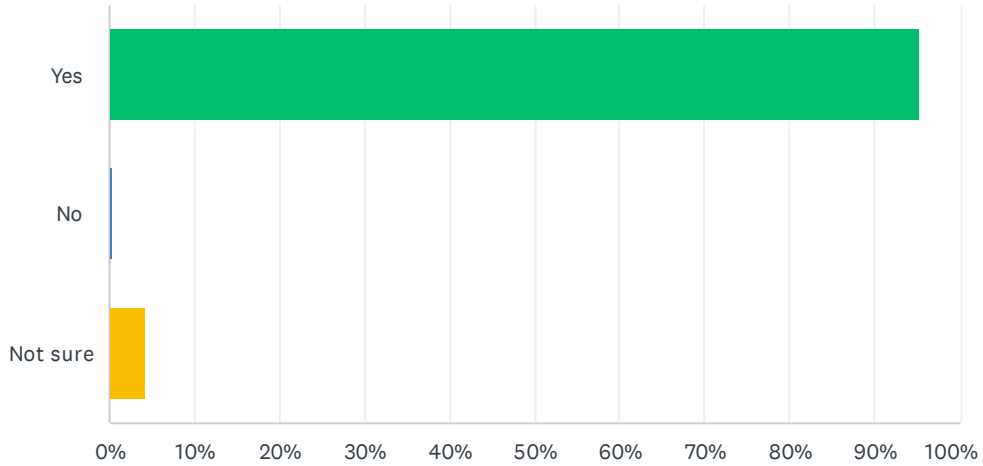

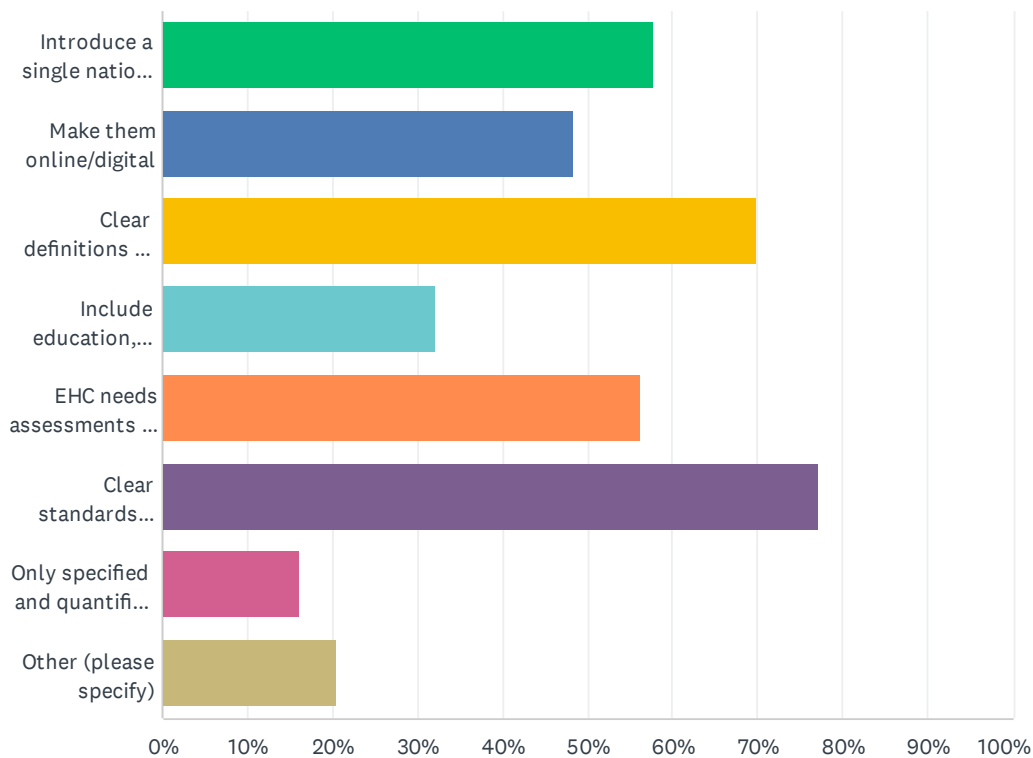

## Q11 What do you think needs to change about EHC Plans?

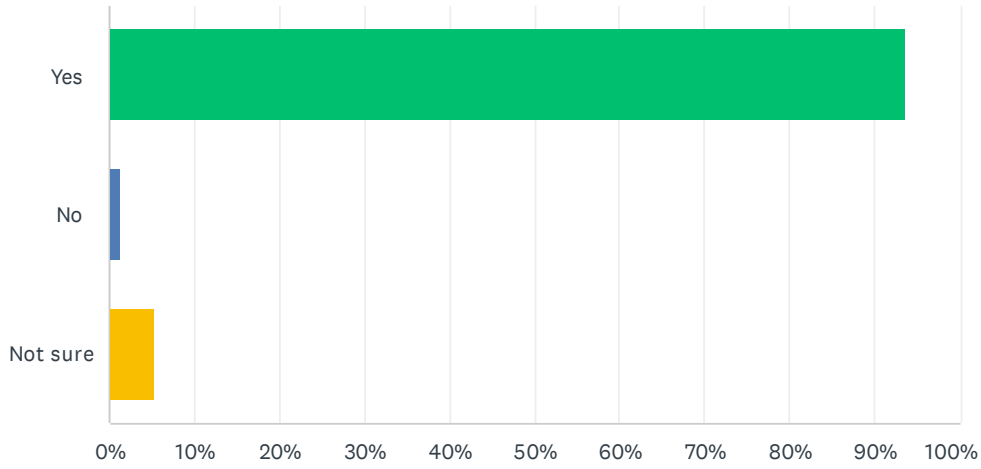

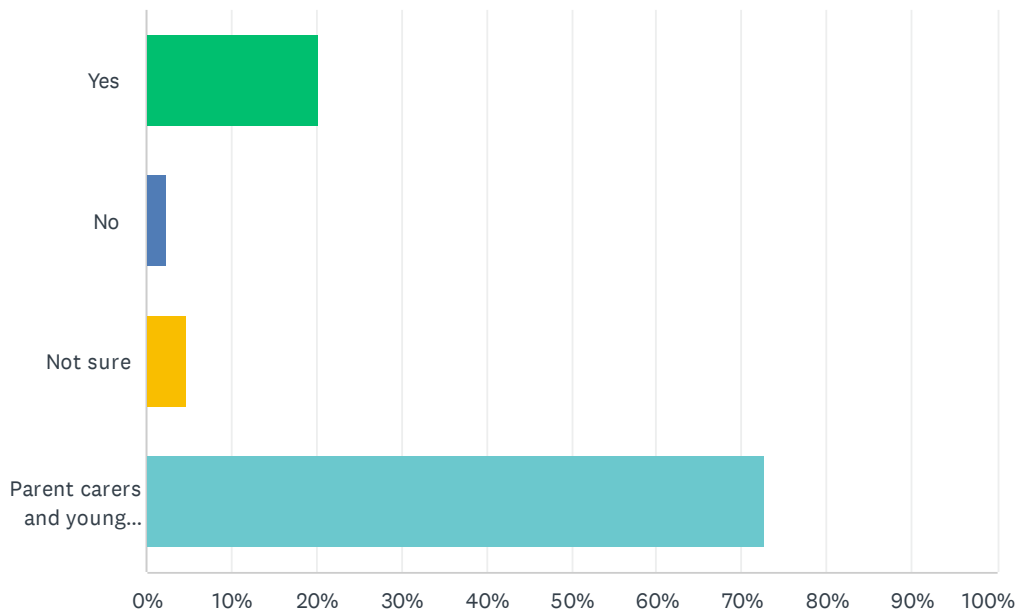

### Q13 Do you agree that children with an EHC Plan should be able to pick a school/setting from a tailored list in their local area?

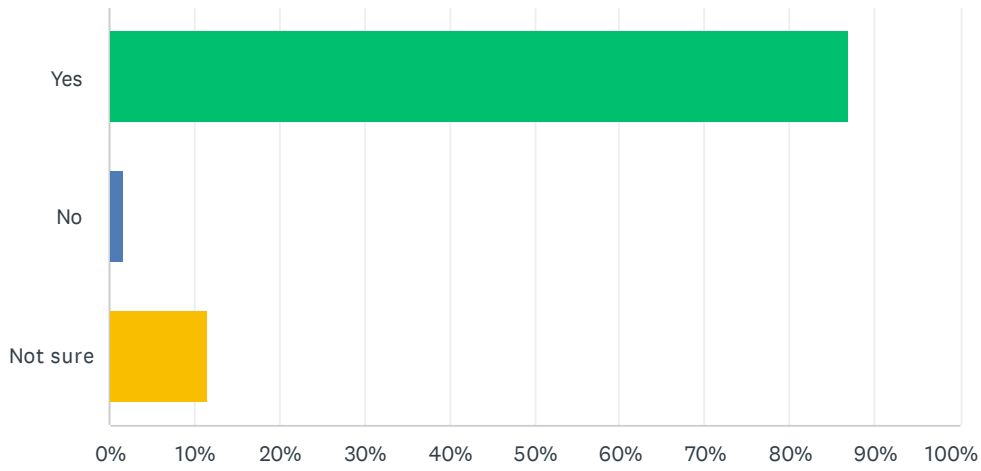

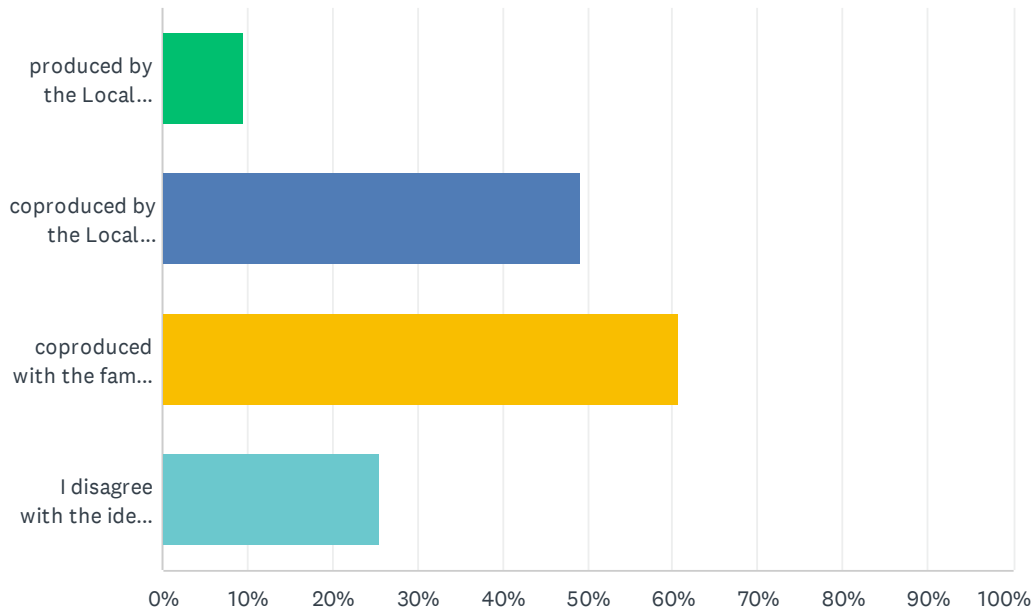

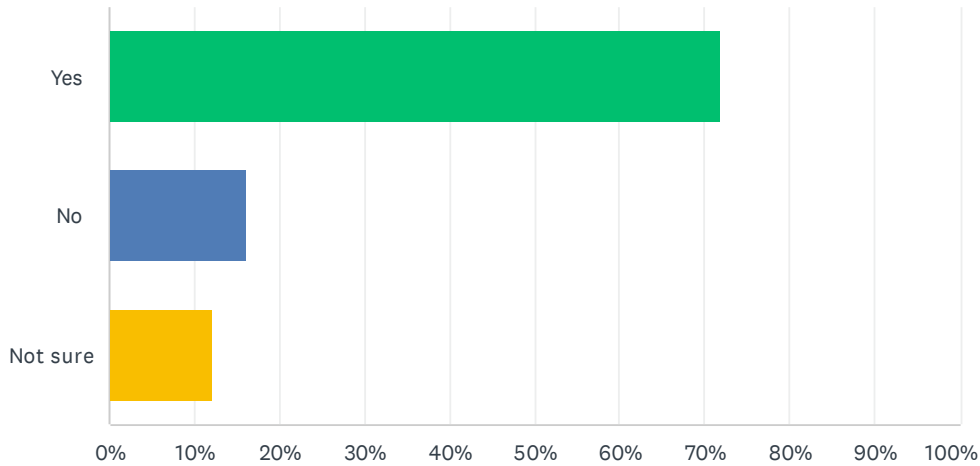

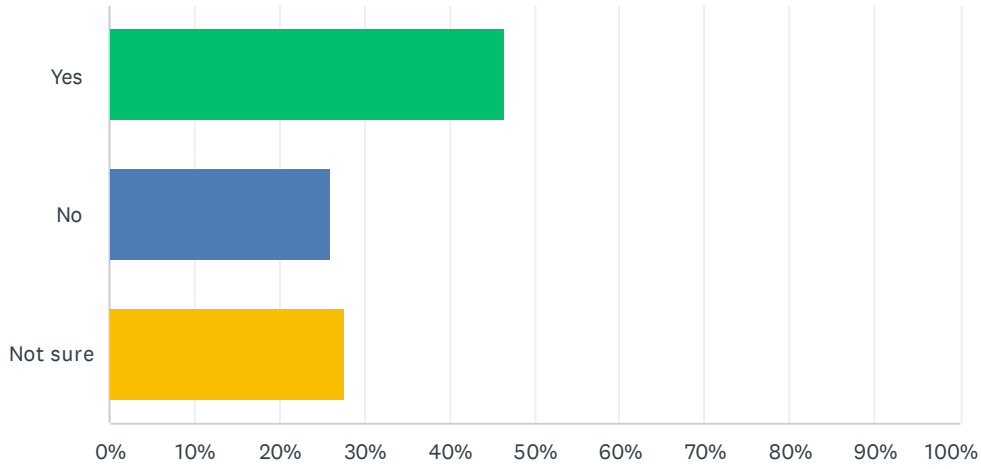

### Q17 Should this mediation be binding? (Should whatever is agreed at mediation be tried before going to tribunal)

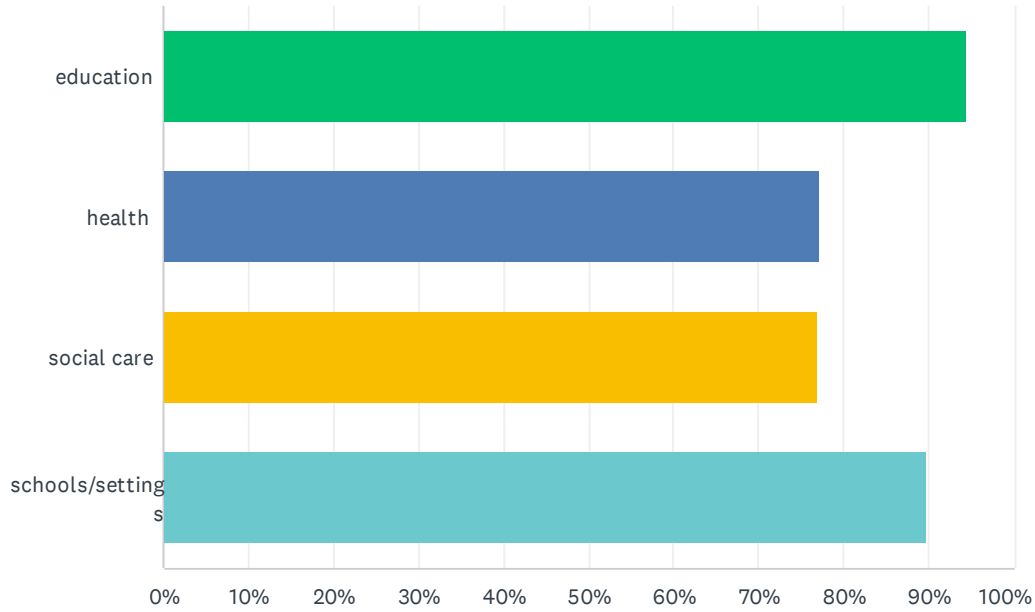

### Q18 Do you think that the SEND Tribunal should have the power to make binding judgements on: (tick all that apply)

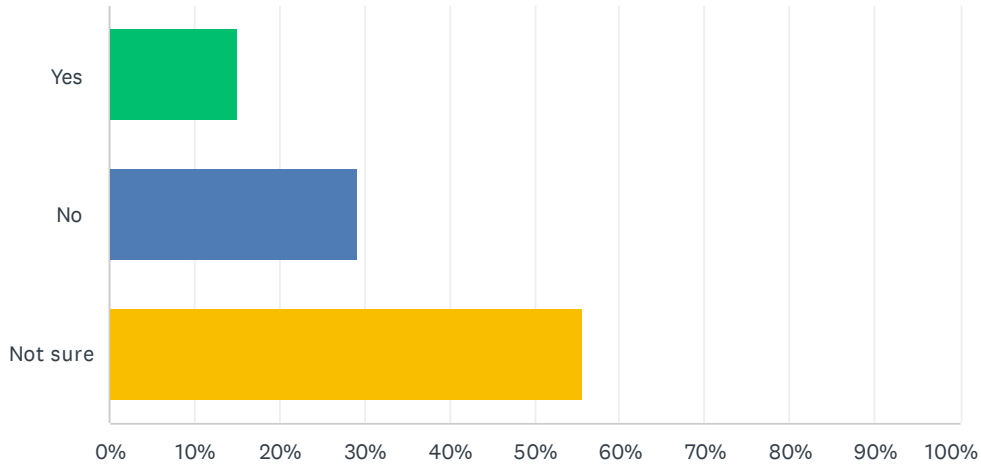

### Q19 Do you think the tribunal process is effective at holding schools/settings to account in cases of discrimination?

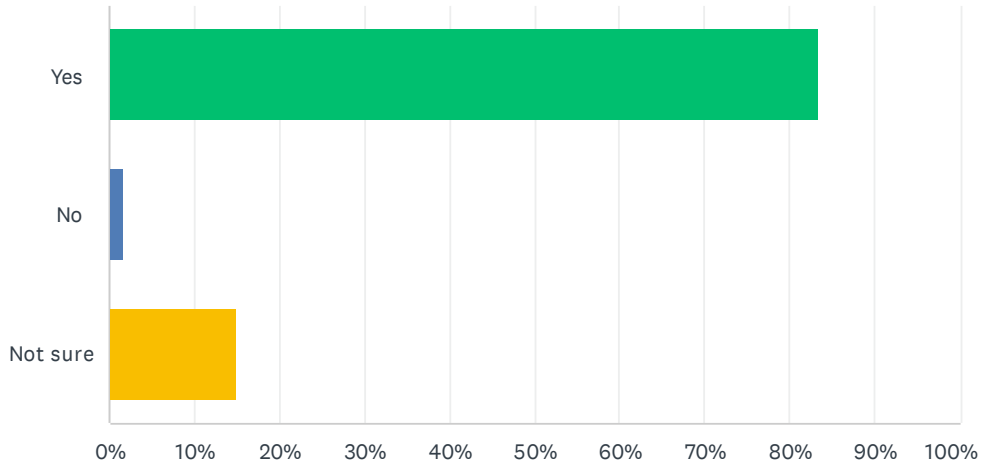

## Q20 Should the SEND Tribunal have additional powers to make schools/settings do what the tribunal is telling them to do?

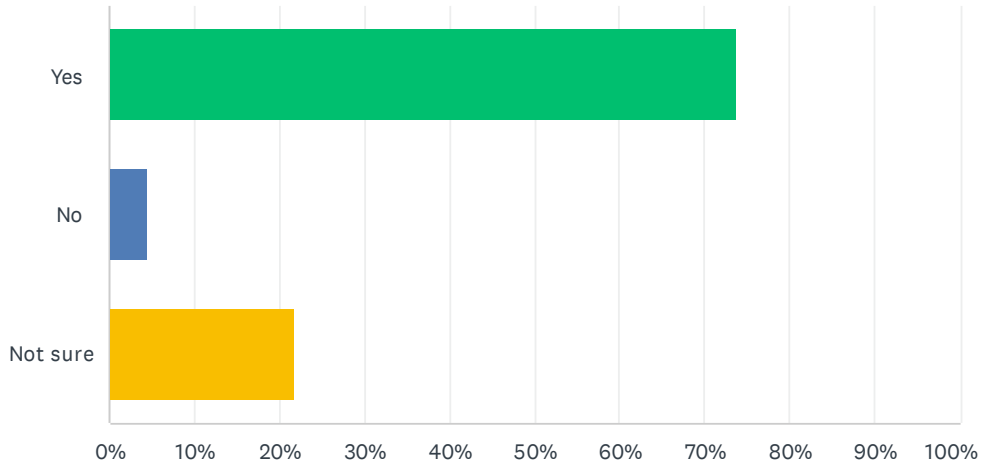

## Q21 Do local authorities need additional extra or additional powers to hold schools/settings to account?

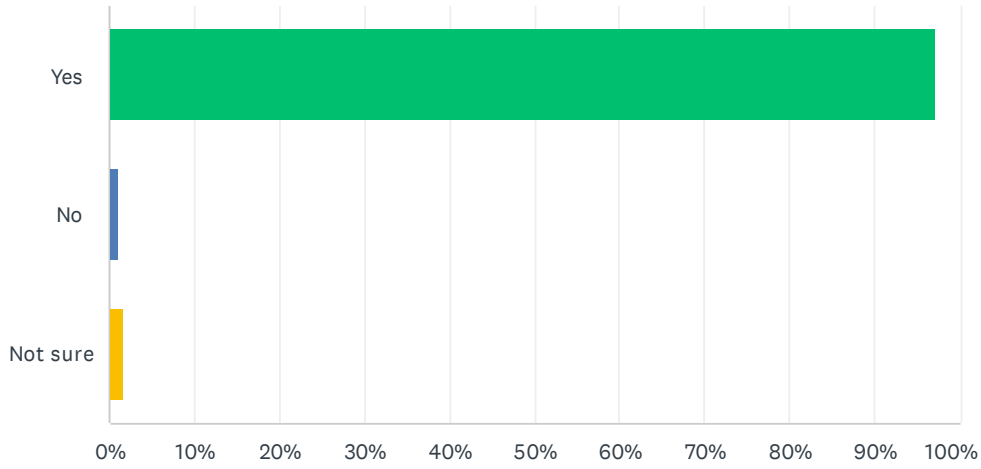

## Q22 Do you think teaching staff need more SEND training to understand and support the children they teach?

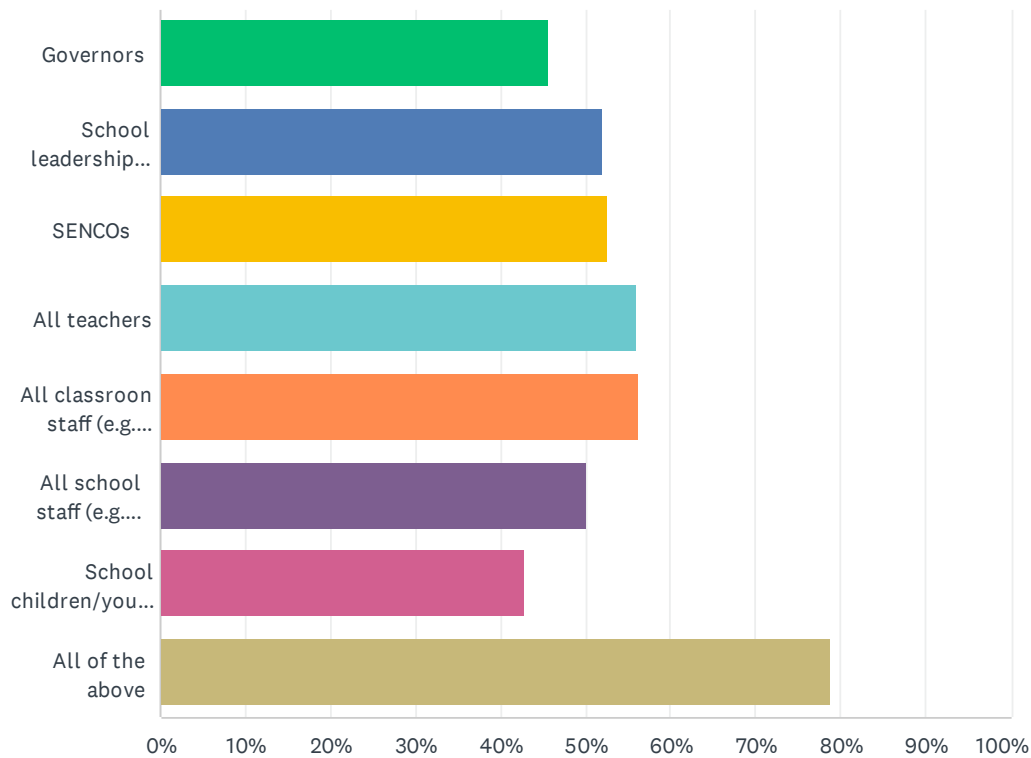

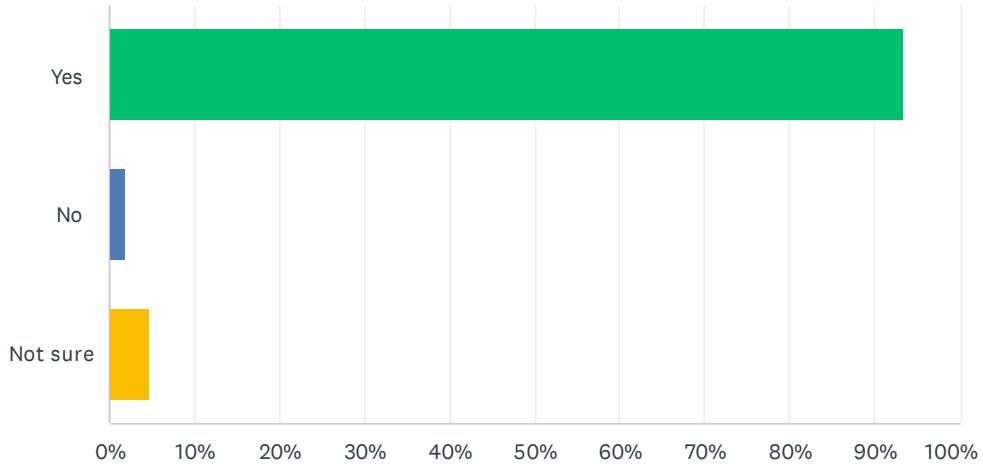

## Q24 Should all SENCOs have to undergo training and gain a qualification before they can do this role?

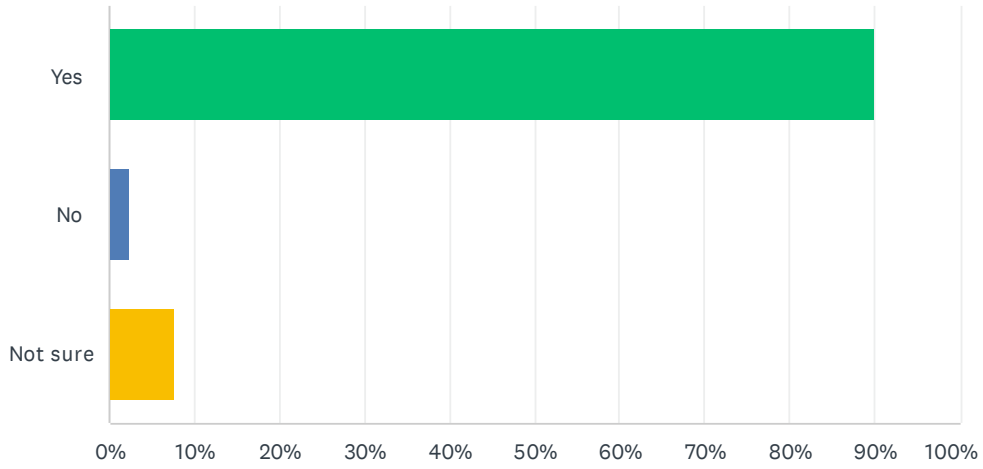

## Q25 Should a member of the school leadership team have specific responsibility for SEND?

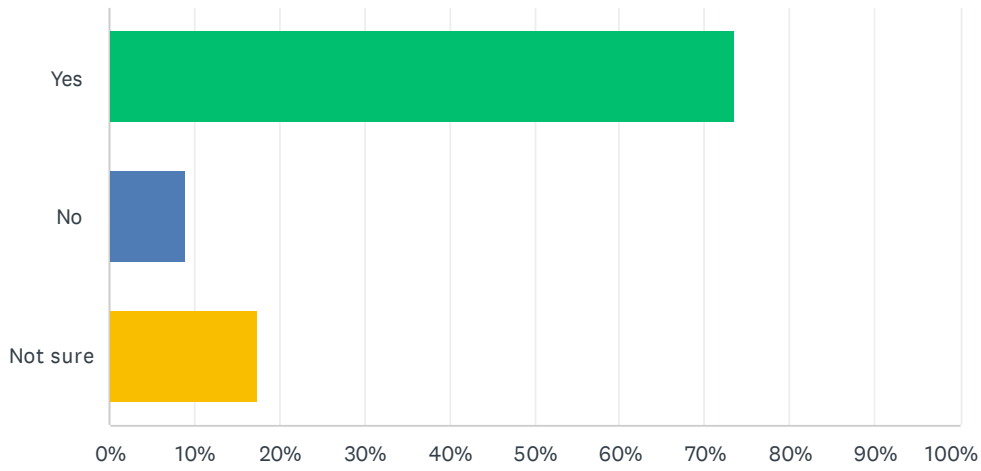

## Q26 Do you think that children and young people with similar needs should get similar amounts of funding regardless of where they live?

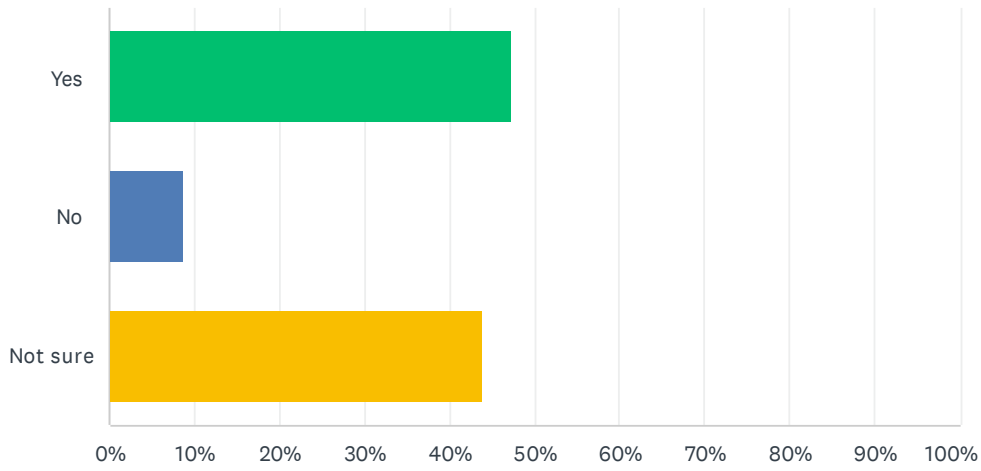

## Q27 Do you think that schools delivering similar provision for a child or young person should be required to charge similar tariffs?

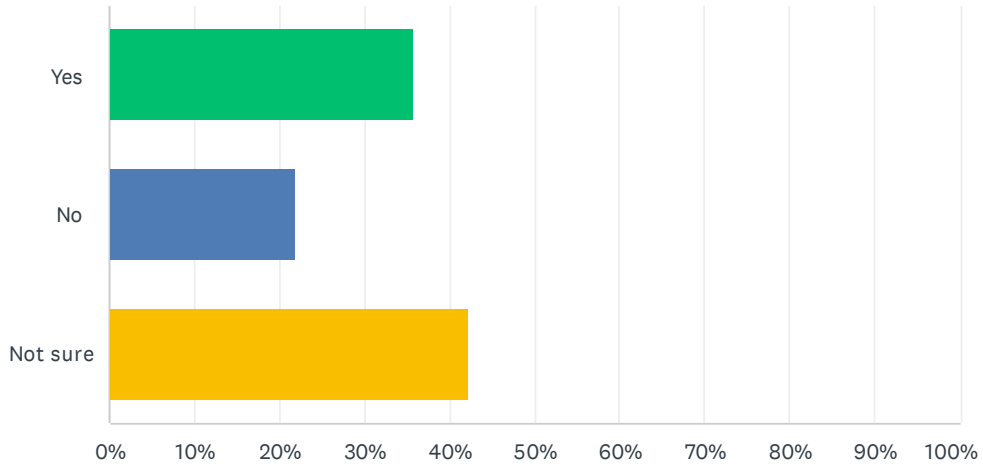

## Q28 Should there be a minimum and a maximum amount that schools can charge for a specific need?

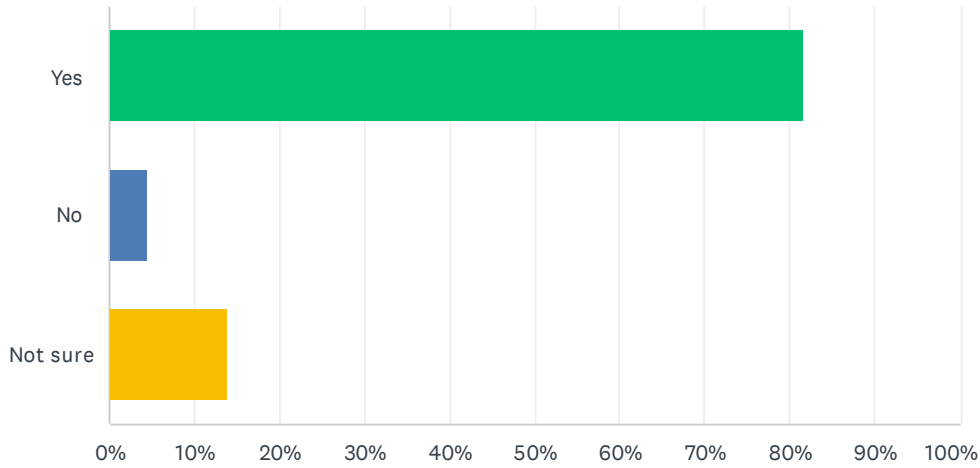
